2024 Kindergarten Supply List

These are just the basics, your child's teacher may give you a class-specific list with additional items on Meet the Teacher Night. Buy yourself a fine-point black Sharpie marker so that you can label your child's backpack, lunch box, water bottle, and the tags of their clothing.

- ★ One <u>full-sized</u> backpack, with <u>NO wheels</u>. Students will need their backpack <u>daily</u>. If you do not want your child's name on the outside for security reasons, consider a backpack keychain/charm or some other unique feature so that your child would easily know their backpack from a friend who has the same exact good taste in backpacks. Backpacks should all be labelled inside.
- ★ 2 cans of Play-Doh, any color.
- * At least one reusable (stainless steel or plastic, not a disposable) water bottle.
- ★ 2 large pink erasers (rectangular, not the pencil-topper style)
- * <u>Crayola</u> Crayons, 2 boxes of 24 crayons (students use one box Aug-Dec, and their second box for Jan-May. PLEASE NO OTHER BRANDS, they're ineffective).
- * Headphones with a microphone for use with a school-owned laptop (not earbud-style, over-the-ear is better for noise cancellation purposes as all students use computers at the same time as they are seated right next to each other).
- * student scissors, one pair
- ★ Dry erase markers (pack of six, black)
- \star 100 index cards 2 packs of 3" \times 5" (blank or ruled, doesn't matter)
- ★ One plastic rectangular pencil box (about 8.25" \times 5.63" in size, to keep all their tools separate from other students' items)
- ★ 4 boxes of facial tissue (one per quarter)
- ★ One plain BLUE poly (plastic) two-pocket folder with prongs inside.
- ★ 8 glue sticks, or one bottle of liquid Elmer's glue (no Dollar-store glue please)
- ★ 12 pencils (Ticonderoga or Dixon brand greatly appreciated)

Our Kindergarten classrooms would be incredibly grateful to receive the following "Wish-list" donations ANY time of year. They are all used communally. You may donate all, some, or none of the following:

- ★ Ziplock-style gallon-sized freezer bags, quart-sized freezer bags, or sandwich bags
- * White card stock
- ★ Reams of white copy/printer paper
- ★ Dry correction tape, Scotch tape, Scotch packing tape (clear, not threaded)
- ★ Packages of diaper wipes (students can safely clean their own desks with these)
- ★ Clorox Wipes (students don't use these but teachers can disinfect their tables/items)
- ★ Heavyweight page protectors
- ★ Thermal lamination sheets $(9 \times 11.5^{\circ\prime\prime}, 3 \text{mm})$ just the sheets, not the machine!
