DISCUSSION	Reentry plan revamped and edited by admin team to account for hybrid learning Parent information meeting from 5-6pm Next _____ to go over what to expectations

	<p>School schedule communicated, grab and go lunch. Hybrid learners go home, then Remote learners will have their lessons via Zoom in the afternoon.</p> <p>Students MUST bring their own water bottle. There will be no drinking fountain access except for one place on campus where water bottles can be refilled with adult assistance.</p> <p>Parents cannot come onto campus at all when we are open for hybrid learning. This especially affects Kinder parents sometimes like to walk their children to their class, which cannot be allowed for safety reasons at this time. . Classes are tightly scheduled for all staff as well as teachers.</p> <p>District is initiating a lot of procedures and policy for returning staff that requires adjustment.</p> <p>All adult staff members have their temp taken before they are allowed in to work, and they have to sign an attestation.</p> <p>Those who are in Hybrid can change their minds to take part in remote learning, but remote learners cannot opt to switch to hybrid learning outside of specific enrollment choice windows.</p> <p>Remote students will work on assignments given by teachers. Teachers will send specific schedules, but here is a sample: 9:30-10:30 - Reading Assignments 10:30-11:30 - Math Assignments 11:30 12:30 - Writing 12:30 – Lunch 1:25 - Math Lesson on Zoom 2:25 - ELA Lesson on Zoom</p> <p>Counseling lessons will also occur during that morning asynchronous time for remote students, this will require that they log on to a Zoom link once per week in the mornings to receive that instruction.</p>
