<u>PARENTING</u>	Annually school staff will use a survey to obtain parental input for quarterly workshop opportunities for families.
<u>COMMUNICATING</u>	Parent, Teacher conferences are a commitment by school staff to keep families informed of student progress. Conferences conducted in a variety of ways during first and third quarters.
<u>VOLUNTEERING</u>	Each family volunteers quarterly for parent-teacher conferences, student performances, workshops and other opportunities provided.
<u>LEARNING AT HOME</u>	Each semester at least one family friendly event offered to inform parents on skills, strategies, resources and ways families could participate in helping students. Workshop topics include literacy, math, science, and college and career readiness.
